File 1	Jennie Pincock: scrapbook: reviews of Trails of Truth. - 1930-1932. Contents: includes inserted material: correspondence, ephemera, seance transcripts, mss., described separately.
File 1b	Jenny Pincock: scrapbook: "first circle" accounts. - 1930. Contents: ms. accounts by participants of a seance which took place in June 1930. Writers include Jenny Pincock and Minnie Maines.
File 1c	Jenny Pincock: scrapbook: loose correspondence. - 1930. Contents: nine letters, 1928-1933, some addressed to Jenny Pincock, one to Mrs. Maines, and an unsigned draft.
File 1d	Jennie Pincock: scrapbook: loose clippings 1930-1934, 1943-1954.
File 1e	Jenny Pincock: scrapbook: loose séance notes. - 1930, 1932 Contents: ts. carbon notes of two sittings, recorded by Jenny Pincock, and one loose draft page. One is Jan. 27, 1930; the other Aug. 16, 1932 at Lily Dale, N.Y.
File 1f	Jennie Pincock: scrapbook: loose ephemera. - 1931, 1933. Contents: cards advertising speakers at the Church of Divine Revelation.
File 1g	Jennie Pincock: scrapbook: loose photographs. - 1931. Contents: two snapshots.
File 2	Séance notes [kept by Margaret Ghent?] - 1929-1931. Contents: original ts. notes with ms. annotations and corrections, som complete pages of ms. notes. Many pages are typed on discarded draft manuscript pages.

File 5	Jenny Pincock: manuscripts [19]. Contents: one folder of mixed ts,. and manuscript material, ca. 75 pages, by Jenny O'Hara Pincock, some fiction, some poetry, written under various names. This material seems to be largely concerned with an account of James O'Hara and other pioneers, as well as stories about pioneers. Titles include "Dunkie spoke to the owl," and "Hidden Spring."
File 6	Minnie Maines: scrapbook. - 1929-1931. Contents: this scrapbook contains only seven pages of clippings pasted in, with annotations by Minnie Maines. Topics include spiritualism in general and the Church of Divine Revelation in particular, and especially the activities of the Rev. F.J.T. Maines. A number of loose clippings were found inserted into this book as well.
File 7	Minnie Maines: scrapbook: loose clippings, undated [193-]. Contents: this scrapbook contains many loose clippings, ephemera. correspondence, manuscript material, and photographs. The clippings are mostly from the Galt Reporter and the St Catharines Standard.
