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GA 91 : Schantz Russell Family

Schantz Russell family fonds. - [ca. 1840] - [ca. 1960]. - ca. 5 m of textual records and other material.

The house at 43 Schneider Ave., Kitchener Ont., was built in 1887-1888 by Tobias and Mary Schantz, and has remained in the family to the present day. Tobias and Mary's granddaughter Dorothy Russell and great-grandson Harold Russell "cleaned out the attic" and although much textual and graphic material remains with the family, the materials donated represent a significant addition to our knowledge and understanding of local history and way of life in 19th-century Ontario, particularly in Kitchener. The more than 1000 letters alone provide insight into the lives of pioneer families, and are especially rich in detailing the concerns of women. The Schantz women may have been atypical: they were well-educated and they worked and travelled; their letters contain everything from the most humdrum details of domestic activities to comments on local and larger affairs. Other textual materials document the education, interests and activities of members of the large and busy Schantz family from the 1850's to ca. 1930. The photographs add to the known body of work of local photographers, most notably Denton, and include some images of important local events, such as the visit of Sir Wilfrid Laurier. The many very early local maps and plans are a significant addition for area research. Ephemera and artifacts are also present.

Papers and books in the attic were stored in trunks, boxes and desks, some belonging to individuals, and some containing general family papers, and the arrangement of the fonds has been determined largely by the way the material was stored. One trunk was labelled "Hervey Bowman": this belonged to a close friend (and cousin?) of Frank Schantz who gave all his things to Frank when he died. One of the most significant local history finds was in this trunk. Hervey's father Isaac Lucius Bowman ran a school at Freeport ca. 1867-1871 which is documented here through the "Proceedings of the Freeport Educational Society", circulars of the Freeport Academy, and two photographs of pupils and teachers of the Academy.

The Schantz Family in North America is large and widespread: spelling of the last name includes variations such as Tschantz, Shantz, Schantz, Shonts, and Schanz. The family as a whole is descended from Jacob Schanz (b. 1710) who emigrated to the United States in 1737 and settled in Pennsylvania. In 1810 Jacob's son Christian came to Waterloo County and settled at Freeport on the Grand River in 1810.

Christian's son Benjamin, born in 1811, was not only an early Waterloo County inhabitant but was one of the founders of Port Elgin, Ont., settling there in 1854 and establishing a grist and flour mill. After his first wife, Lydia Kolb, died in 1862, Benjamin, then 52, quickly remarried, this time to his 23-year old housekeeper, Margaret Swinton. He then left Port Elgin with his new wife and settled in Dallas County, Missouri. Correspondence from him to his son Tobias recounts his life there and is full of details illuminating settlers' experiences in the United States at the time.

The Schantz/Russell Family Papers centres around Tobias and Mary Schantz and their family, drawing together primary sources relating to several early pioneering families of Waterloo County, primarily Schantz, Moyer and Bowman families, and includes also materials relating to descendants of the Moyer pioneers of Lincoln County, Ont. Tobias was born in Freeport in 1842, the fifth of Benjamin Schantz's 15 children, and moved to Port Elgin (christened "Normanton" by the Post Office) in 1854. There he met Mary Moyer, who was descended from Samuel Meyer who came to Lincoln County, Canada West, in 1800. The Moyers were generally fairly well educated; some of Mary's school papers from the 1850's survive in the collection. The two families were closely connected before this time, as Moyers were also fairly widespread in Waterloo County. Tobias' siblings and cousins were spread from Port Elgin to Alberta (where a large contingent of Schantz's had gone) to the mid-west and western United States. Mary Schantz's eight siblings all travelled and settled more than once, from Pennsylvania to Berlin, Ont., to Iowa and Illinois. The correspondence among members of this generation reflects the way of life and concerns of these very mobile settlers of the 1860's and 1870's.

Tobias and Mary married in 1863 and had eight children. In 1864 Tobias attended the Eastman National Business College in Poughkeepsie, N.Y.; a good deal of his work from that year survives to document business education of the time. Tobias worked in mills for many years; in 1866 he and Mary moved from Port Elgin to Hawkesville, in 1877 to Conestogo and in 1883 to Berlin, where they lived at first on Benton Street. In 1887 they bought two acres of land from Samuel Schneider and built a house, 43 Schneider Ave., where the family resides to the present day. Tobias became a book agent and a nursery stock agent for various companies including E.D. Smith, and in 1900 went to Alberta with some of his sons to homestead. Back home in 1907, he continued to pursue his business interests to his death in 1925. From the diaries, notebooks and correspondence he kept, he would appear to have been a sensitive and introspective character, deeply concerned with spiritual matters. His letters and diaries show him in his role as husband and father, and illuminate family life at the time, whereas his business papers shed light on the literary tastes of the community as well as on local gardening

and landscaping.

Tobias and Mary Schantz had eight children, whose lives are documented to varying degrees in the fonds:

Orpheus (1864-1951) worked first for his uncle Levi N. Moyer in Cedar Falls, Iowa and then moved to Chicago. Although he made his living as a dry goods merchant he had an abiding interest in ornithology, botany, geography and geology. He was an early member of the Geographical Society and was a popular author and lecturer. Many of his letters to his brother Frank are present in the collection. He was a prolific and engaging correspondent.

Etta (1866-1900) trained to be a teacher in Berlin, Ontario and also worked in Chicago from 1893-1897 while staying with Orpheus and his family. She married Ward White in 1897; in 1900 he went to Alberta with Etta's brothers and father to homestead. Etta died in May of that year, shortly after giving birth to Dorothy White, now Dorothy Russell. There are approximately 100 letters present written by Etta, most to her sister Sophie, but others to her father and family. Some correspondence by Ward White is also present.

Sophie (1869-1958) trained in Chicago at the Chicago Froebel Association to be a kindergarten teacher. She was never able to work as a teacher, however: she returned to Berlin after Etta's death to help care for the baby and found her certificate invalid for kindergarten teaching in Ontario. Sophie worked for many years as clerk and then head of the china department at Woolworth's and retired in the 1930's. There is present in the fonds much correspondence written to Sophie from family and friends, as well as a small amount of ephemera material belonging to her.

Austin (1871-1959) also worked in Chicago for a time before moving to Council Bluffs, Iowa, thence to Alberta to homestead. There is correspondence present from Austin, mostly to his brother Frank and sister Sophie.

Frank (1874-1962) is well represented in the fonds by correspondence and other textual materials as he remained at 43 Schneider Ave., working at R.D. Lang dry goods until retirement in the 1930's. He acted as head of the family, helping support his mother, sisters, niece Dorothy and his father Tobias, looking after family affairs both locally and in Alberta. He was also an enthusiastic bird-watcher and amateur naturalist, traits which seem to run in the family. Frank was active in community work and served as secretary-treasurer of the K-W Orphanage Board, helped found the K-W Field Naturalists, belonged to the Waterloo Historical and K-W Philatelic Societies, was active in the United Brethren and was President of the Schantz Family Reunion Association for many years.

Arthur (1876-1958) homesteaded in Alberta and remained there the rest of his life. He is represented in the fonds by correspondence to his brother Frank. There are a few childhood papers and drawings done by Austin and Arthur which were preserved and among Florence's belongings.

Florence (1879 - 1938) spent varying periods of time between 1900 and 1912 keeping house for her brothers Arthur and Austin in Alberta. After that she worked at Woolworth's until her death in 1938. There are many letters from her to Sophie in the fonds. Two trunks of Florence's childhood belongings give insight into a girl's life of the period, containing scrapbooks, poetry, decoupage cutouts, clippings, schoolbooks, music, etc.

Herbert (1883-1912) was the last child, was always in poor health and suffered from epilepsy. There are a few letters from him present in the fonds.

The Bowman Family papers which are present in this fonds result from Frank's friendship with Hervey Bowman (perhaps also his cousin?), who left all his belongings to Frank when he died. Some of the most significant local material in the fonds originates with the Bowman family. Isaac Lucius Bowman was born at Freeport in 1830, and was founder and principal of the Freeport Academy from 1867-1872. This very early educational institution is here documented with Proceedings of the Academy, ephemera, and two photographs of the members of the Academy. I. L. Bowman then trained to be a Provincial Land Surveyor, and many of the very early plans and maps in the fonds are from the Bowman Family belongings. Of his four sons, three also became surveyors and Engineers, while Hervey attended the Universities of Toronto and the Leipzig. His files relate mostly to his educational pursuits, but include some other family-related materials.

Schantz/Russell family: accrual 2000. - 1881-1951.

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Contents: The bulk of this accrual consists of correspondence from Orpheus Moyer from 1881 to 1951, the year he died, adding significantly to the holdings of family letters.

Schantz Russell Family : 2003 accrual. - [189-]-1994. - 1.5 m of textual records. - 2821 photographs.

Contents: this accrual consists primarily of textual and graphic material belonging to or created by Dorothy Russell, including her diaries, correspondence and photograph albums. Includes also a small amount of Schantz Reunion material, the 1913 register. The photograph albums originally belonged to different members of the family.

Schantz Russell Family fonds : 2005 accrual. - 1856-2005. - 35 cm textual records. - 9 photographs.

Accrual consists primarily of textual and graphic materials created or accumulated by Dorothy White Russell during her enrolment as a student at the Kitchener and Waterloo Collegiate Institute and the Toronto Normal School, respectively, from 1916 to 1921. Also contains miscellaneous materials created or accumulated by Etta Schantz, including school certificates, provincial and county school examination papers and ephemera such as advertising and greeting cards. Includes as well, materials relating to the Schantz-Russell Family; among these are publications and clippings.

Contents: series is comprised of materials created and accumulated by Florence Annie Catherine Schantz. Includes diaries, scrapbooks, ephemera, school books, an autograph book and artifacts.

Contents: small notebook with household accounts, expenses associated with Etta's death and burial, lists of expenses associated with "Baby" and "Dorothy", also "North West Accounts" listing expenses for Tobias and Austin in Alberta.

File consists of two greeting cards in booklet form received by Florence Schantz.
- File 35 **Autograph book.** - 1889-1893.
Contents: Consists of a small autograph book with gilded embossed cover and small pictorial Victorian cuts pasted beside some entries.
- File 36 **Diary notes.** - ca. 1885-1904.
Contents: Consists of a small volume (8. cm) published by the American Tract Society entitled A Threefold Cord containing an bible verses for every day in the year. The flyleaf is signed by Florence and is dated 13-7-85. She has used the margins of this volume to write notes or information alongside appropriate dates, such as deaths, burials, parties, etc.

Contents: Consists of 3 p. ms transcription (?) of a hymn, all written on the verso of pages from ledgers, possibly from a shirt or clothing factory, and containing ledger lists of "Machine Hands" and "Buttonhole Hands", all women's names with accompanying numbers. Buttonhole hands include Emily Devitt and Mrs Joachimi (mother or grandmother of Norman Schneider's wife)

Contents: Consists of a long manuscript poem by Mary Woods, 1894, (transcribed by Florence?) entitled "Our Trip to Elora", and inserted in a pamphlet of shadowgraphs sold by the "deaf and dumb".

Contents: Consists of notes on Paul and David.

Contents: Consists of a notebook kept by Florence Schantz, not complete. The cover is dated Feb. 28, 1908, Didsbury, Alberta and contains hymns transcribed from memory.
- File 46 **School Exercise Books.** - 1894-1896.
Contents: Consists of 16 scribblers or exercise books, most with pictorial covers, owned by Florence Schantz. File 46 is the first of three files
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- File 48 **School Exercise Books.** - 1894-1896.
Contents: Consists of 16 scribblers or exercise books, most with pictorial covers, owned by Florence Schantz. File 48 is the third of three files.
- File 49 **School Exercise Books: Copy Books.** - 1890-1896.
Contents: Consists of 15 copy books for drawing and writing, owned by Florence Schantz.
- File 50 **Scrapbook 1.** - ca. 1880-ca. 1892.
Contents: This scrapbook consists of news clippings relating primarily to the Salvation Army and contains poetry, engraved and photographic portraits of Salvation Army figures and events("The Reception March on Yonge Street" shows a street full of marchers turning the corner at "Simpsons". The name "Sophia E. Schantz" is written on the flyleaf. This scrapbook is actually a store ledger from 1864-1865. Every second page has been cut out to accommodate the bulk of pasted-in clippings. The pages have not been completely covered. Names would appear to be local to this area?
- File 51 **Scrapbook 2.** - ca.1880-ca.1887.
Contents: This scrapbook consists of newspaper clippings from ca.1887, primarily poetry and pictorial items. Included are poetry about Kansas, items about Britain's and Germany's Royal families, fashion items, and sentimental pictures and poems. The scrapbook-maker has employed gilt and silver labels from cloth and embroidery thread to provide fancy borders for some items. Some loose pages and clippings are present, as well as loose ms transcriptions, with music, of four hymns, "The Ransomed of the Lord", "A Golden Harp in Glory", "I Will Sing for Jesus" and "Never be Afraid", signed by Etta Schantz. The volume used for this scrapbook appears to be a soft-cover publisher's dummy for an edition of the Bible. Not all pages are covered, and the existing engraved portraits (of Moses and Jesus) have been left intact. The centre pages for recording births, marriages, and deaths, have been filled in with information on the children of Tobias and Mary Schantz, up to the birth of Dorothy Etta White in 1900. The cover of the volume has a pictorial clipping pasted on entitled "Green's Atlas, 1880."
- File 52 **Scrapbook 3.** - ca.1881-ca.1885?
Contents: This scrapbook consists of newspaper clippings, both loose and pasted in, including poetry and illustrations, a brochure for the Niagara and Lewiston Railroad, and a one-leaf printed advertisement for "Sapolio", this last in both English and German and printed on silver-backed paper. Although some items are religious in nature, the content of the clippings is lighter in tone and less "sentimental" than in the other scrapbooks. This scrapbook has the name "Franklin A. Schantz, Berlin, Ontario, Canada, written on the front cover. This scrapbook occupies the first twenty-five pages of a volume entitled "Business Diary Containing General Information, With Daily Calendar for 1881, Compiled by Ogilvy & Co., Toronto, And Presented to Each of their Customers With Best Respects and Cordial Good Wishes." Ogilvy & Co. were importers of British and foreign dry goods, and wholesale dealers in Canadian cottons, woolens, etc. As well as a good deal of contemporary "quick reference" information about Canadian and other politics, geography and history, this volume contains full-page advertisements for other Toronto businesses, and lists of items available from Ogilvy & Co. This latter provides information of what was generally available for clothing and hand-work in Canada at the time.
- File 53 **Scrapbook 4.** - ca.1900.
Contents: This scrapbook consists of newspaper clippings, mostly engraved portraits of members of the British and Russian royal families. The flyleaf is signed "Florence Schantz, Dec. 1900". This scrapbook occupies the first twenty pages of a publisher's dummy entitled House and Home: Complete Housewife's Guide / by Marion Harland (Toronto, W. Briggs, [[19--?]]), and every second leaf in this section has been cut out to accommodate the bulk of the clippings. The rest of the volume, originally published in the United States for an American audience, contains a sample of chapters and engravings on everything from home decorating, relationships, child-rearing, etiquette, menus and recipes. At the end of the volume Tobias Schantz has written the names of customers and the binding style ordered by each.

Contents: This scrapbook consists of newspaper clippings of poetry for children, and is signed on the inside front cover "Florence Schantz, Dec. 1900". This scrapbook occupies four pages of a publisher's dummy entitled: Life and Achievements of Admiral Dewey . . . / by Murat Halstead (Philadelphia: People's Publishing Co., 1899), and every second and third leaf in this volume has been cut out to accommodate the bulk of the clippings.

Contents: This volume is truly a "scrap" book, containing coloured cuttings, some printed for the purpose, with the majority being floral items cut from seed catalogues, many loose. The burgundy leather cover is heavily tooled in a thistle pattern, and includes a coloured pictorial card of a bluebird pasted on.

*Contents: This scrapbook consists of large illustrations pasted in. Largely from illustrated papers, these items originally accompanied stories or poems (some illustrate fishing, hunting, etc.). (Tobias' father Benjamin with his second wife Margaret and children had gone to homestead near Wellville, west of St. Louis, in 1866.) He records his impressions of the countryside, the people, the prospects, the discouragement of all but his father with life in Missouri (March 17th). On July 2 he returns to Canada to where he is then living (near "Campden" --Grimsby within walking distance.) Throughout the diary Tobias records the weather and a daily health bulletin, letters sent and received, as well as his daily reading. He goes through periods of recording his meals, (he does not list what he ate in any menu order that we would recognize, and includes every food item, even those we would consider condiments. He lists vinegar, butter, molasses and water, among other things). Tobias also lists all the work he does every day -- the small details build into a good picture of everyday life and his role in the family -- he mentions setting the water for porridge, making the bed, polishing his son's shoes, carrying the baby to church, etc. On Nov. 9 he took a bath, On Nov. 25 he "did not sleep short of midnight. Was talking with Mary about my thought, troubles about religion ...". All parts of the diary have been filled with writing, dating as far as 1889 -- some accounts, recipes both household and medical (many give source), a record of the family tree -- births, marriages, deaths, transcribed songs, and an account probably written in Conestogo ca. 1875 of his spiritual trials and tribulations dating from 1862 and his efforts to achieve inner peace. This account is continued in the "other book" ???.

- File 43 **Art reproduction cards. - [18-?].**
File consists of ten cards showing reproductions of works of art in black and white. The images are predominately religious in nature depicting the Madonna and scenes from the life of Christ.
- File 44 **Bible cards. - [18-?].**
File consists of four printed cards with Biblical images and passages.
- File 45 **Certificates of deportment. - 1879.**
File consists of nine certificates issued to Etta Shantz and signed by her teacher, G.A. McIntyre attesting that she received no discredit marks for the period January-November, 1879 while attending the Conestoga Public School. The certificates have printed images of birds on recto.
Cards were found in the original envelope addressed by hand to Miss Etta Schantz, West Montrose, Ontario.
- File 46 **Christmas card : handmade card by Etta Schantz for Ward White. - 1890.**
File consists of a Christmas card in booklet form made by Etta Schantz for her future husband, Ward White, in 1890. The card includes an ms. poem and has plant material attached throughout.
- File 47 **Christmas cards. - [189-?].**
File consists of five family greeting cards to and from Etta Schantz.
- File 48 **County of Waterloo : promotion examinations. - 1879-1881.**
File consists of sixteen printed promotion examinations issued by the County of Waterloo [School Board] containing questions on various subjects including English history, grammar and composition, geography, reading and literature, and arithmetic.
- File 49 **Education Department, Ontario : examinations : admission to high schools. - 1879-1884..**
File consists of twelve printed examinations issued by the Education Department of the Province of Ontario in various subjects including spelling, geography, arithmetic, composition and English literature in accordance with the program of studies required for admission to high schools.
- File 50 **Education Department, Ontario : examinations : third class teachers. - 1886.**
File consists of a printed set of fourteen midsummer examinations issued by the Education Department, Province of Ontario in various subjects including arithmetic, writing, euclidian geometry, German and history. The examinations appear to be part of the requirements of the program of study in preparation for normal or teacher training school.

File consists one music booklet containing words and music to various popular songs. It is possible the booklet was distributed by the publisher, The S. Brainard's Sons Co. at the World's Columbian Exposition (World's Fair) in Chicago in 1893 since the cover page makes reference to the fair.
- File 57 **Penmanship sample.** - [18-?].
File consists of one numbered sample of penmanship, possibly taken from a book of samples. It is in the form of an invitation with "Ladies' Hand" written at the top.
- File 58 **Public Schools of the County of Waterloo : pupil's certificate of promotion.** - 1879.
File consists of a certificate issued by the Public Schools Inspector's Office, Public Schools of the County of Waterloo, on April 18, 1879, certifying that Emma Shantz[sic], pupil at the Conestoga Public School, has been promoted to the fifth class. The certificate is signed by Thomas Pearce, Public School Inspector and George A. McIntyre, teacher.
- File 59 **Public Schools of the County of Waterloo : pupil's certificate of promotion.** - 1881.
File consists of a certificate issued by the Public Schools Inspector's Office of the Public Schools of the County of Waterloo on November 1, 1881 certifying that Emma Shantz[sic], pupil at the Conestoga Public School, has been promoted to the sixth class. The certificate is signed by Thomas Pearce, Public School Inspector and George McIntyre, teacher.

This booklet is the "annual circular" of the Cochran Co. and alternates blank pages with a catalogue of dry goods carried. Orpheus Schantz began to use this as a drawing book in 1878, and it contains drawings in pencil of animals both domestic and foreign, each signed and dated.
