Contents: The materials in this collection were assembled by Seagram Museum staff from a number of sources and reflect the museum's focus on the beverage alcohol industry in the North American context. This fonds also contains accession registers, correspondence, invoice copies, purchase order copies, and other materials relating to the acquisition of book and archival material by the Seagram Museum Library and Archives. Seagram Museum: Artifacts.

Extent is measured in linear metres of shelf space as occupied by the fonds. Donated in 1997 by The Seagram Museum and The Seagram Company. Detailed finding aid available.

The Seagram Museum collections were dispersed to a number of institutions, including The City of Waterloo, Wilfrid Laurier University, and Brock University in St. Catharines. The archives of The Seagram Company after 1928 are housed at the Hagley Museum, Wilmington, Delaware, as are the Bronfman Family papers.

Seagram Memorabilia Collection. - 1765-1926. - 4 cm of textual records.

The Seagram Memorabilia Collection was originally housed at the Seagram Information Centre in Lasalle, Quebec, and was moved to the Seagram Museum in the early 1980's. After the Museum's closure in 1997 this collection was distributed among the various recipients of the Museum's archival and library holdings. Some items related in scope are included in this series although they were later acquisitions.

Contents: series consists of documents illustrative of some aspects of the history of beverage alcohol, particularly in North America. Contains correspondence, ephemera, manuscripts and newspapers relating to the shipment of wine and alcohol to Canada in the late eighteenth and early nineteenth centuries, to eighteenth-century distilling processes, to a single piece of ephemera relating to prohibition in Canada in the 1920's.
